1. Assessment of climate consequences and vulnerability for the macro-region (data networks, knowledge and methodologies for cross-border assessments)
2. Support of knowledge transfer between regions and countries
3. Strengthening of cross-border adaptive actions in different sectors (with divided responsibilities between the countries and the EU)
- 4. Financial support of trans-national activities like protection of sensitive ecosystems, financing of renovation of vulnerable infrastructure**
5. Involvement of relevant stakeholders to mainstream trans-national adaptation measures
6. Integration of adaptation issues into the private sector (e.g. insurance)

1. Installing transnational forms of funding, e.g. by Partnership Agreements for the implementation of the Cohesion Policy
2. Mainstreaming of cc adaptation to existing programmes/funds (LIFE+; Research Programme of Nordstar, European Territorial Co-operation programmes, funds for civil protection)
3. Stronger integration of climate change adaptation aspects into the Rural Development Policy, national strategies for sustainability, biodiversity etc.
4. Including in EU directives like the Marine Strategy Framework Directive and Water Framework Directive and Environmental Impact Assessments
5. Integration into current reviews of roadmaps regarding spatial planning, Integrated Coastal Zone Management (ICZM); the Baltic Sea Action Plan of HELCOM
